A great way for you to support us whilst having a bit of a flutter! Here's how it works

For only £1 a month, per number. This can be taken annually at £12 by standing order, or you can simply pay annually by cheque. This buys you one membership number of your choice, which enters you into the monthly draw. Members are allowed a maximum of three numbers at £1 per month each.

All participants must be over 18.

The draw will take place on the last Friday of the month each month.

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If you win, a cheque will be posted to your home address or left in school and the winning numbers published in the school's weekly newsletter.

1st prize is £30, and 2nd prize is £10. In addition to the bonus months of September and January in which 1st prize is £100, 2nd prize £30, and 3rd prize £10.
